

Outline of Curriculum – Levels 1, 2 and 3

Each year the curriculum begins with a few topics on Allāhﷻ, the Qur'an, the Nabiﷺ, the Hadith, or Sunnah. In the early years, emphasis is placed on the five-pillars, and each year, this emphasis increases. Every year, a history of some of the messengers is introduced in an age-appropriate manner. Several lessons are devoted to Islamic manners, values, and morals so that children grow up with a good understanding of Islamic culture. Each lesson includes a short homework assignment.
